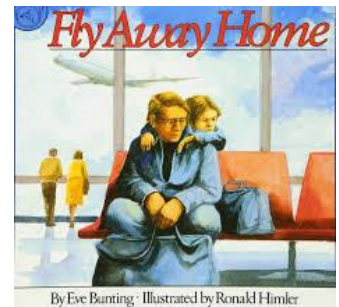

Guided Discussion Questions

The MFLN Early Intervention team seeks to provide practitioners with resources that support the important work they do with military families. These guided discussion questions are designed to be used with children from ages 3-6 at home or in preschool settings. These questions can be used with children who have a loved one in the military or children who want to gain a better understanding of military life.

Fly Away Home by Eve Bunting

1. What do you like the most about your home?
2. Have you ever tried to hide like the boy in the story? Where did you hide?
3. Have you ever slept somewhere that wasn't your bed? Where? Was it fun? How did you feel when you woke up the next morning?
4. What helps you to feel safe when you are scared?
5. The bird in the story tries to get out of the airport over and over again. Describe a time you tried over and over to do something. Did you eventually do it?
6. Have you ever been in an airport? Why were you there?
