

# Medicare Changes in 2022

For almost sixty years, Medicare has provided health insurance for Americans aged 65 and older as well as other qualifying individuals. Medicare basically covers individuals the same way regardless of where they live or their level of income; but, it's a sprawling program and many beneficiaries do not realize all the benefits to which they're entitled. During this session, we will discuss the core elements of the Medicare program and major benefits available under the various "parts."
